NEELEY LOG CLUB CHALLENGE

Competition Rules

- The Log holder will accept challenges based on the official challenger list (every second month). This list will be maintained by Squash BOP. It is the responsibility of the holder to make contact with the challenger before the start of the challenge period, or immediately following the previous challenge (within 2 weeks), whichever is sooner.
- 2. Only fully affiliated BOP clubs are eligible to challenge
- 3. Challenges to be played over one day.
- 4. All players to play two matches. One match against each player in their grade from the opposition. One match per player may be played by mutual agreement (e.g 1 plays 1, 2 plays 2).
- 5. First round injuries must default second round game (if applicable). (NO SUBSTITUTES).
- 6. Playing strength to be taken from the current BOP grading list at the time of the arranged challenge. Eligibility date to be taken a 7 days before the challenge or on a mutually agreed date.
- 7. Players MUST BE on the grading list of the club they are representing.
 Players transferring on or off your grading list for the purpose of other competitions are not eligible. Exception for those with official dispensation to be on another clubs grading for another competition (e.g. part of a composite team that has been ratified by Squash BOP)
- 8. When submitting teams, only grades to be supplied not names.
- 9. The holders announce their team (grades), then the challengers match. Both teams to adhere to rule 10.
- 10. If more than 3 players in any 1 grade that grade must be contested by at least 1 player preferably 2. Clubs who have registered graded players will have to default their matches if they cannot play.
- If agreement is not reached between the two clubs the host club is to contact the BOP Office for clarification
- 12. Playing order to be decided by mutual agreement prior to the first match of the day.
- 13. In the event of a tie after count back of games & points won & lost the winner will be the current holder.
- 14. Each challenge must be completed within allocated period otherwise the challenge is forfeited and the next club in line challenges. If a challenge is forfeited the next challenger may be bought forward to the current period.

The Neeley Log is a competitive club challenge trophy, but the spirit of the Log is for clubs to engage together in a positive, social atmosphere. Clubs are encouraged to be flexible and accommodating as much as possible when applying the above rules.



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
