

Superchamps Team Information 2021



Entries

Entry Fee \$125 per team and is payable at time of entry. Clubs have been invoiced by Squash BOP

You can make any changes to your team until 14th June. After 14th June you can only make minor changes as per the full rules.

Final playing order should be advised at the Managers Meeting prior to commencement of the first round. Playing order is taken from the 11th June grading list.

Playing Order Rule: Within each half grade players may be submitted in order of playing strength to a maximum of 100 points difference (e.g. an B2 with 1950 points may play above an B2 with 2000 points - 50 points difference between the players, however they may not play ahead of someone with 2100 points as there is more than 100 points difference).

Note: F/J must play in points order (as per 11th June)

Players

All players must be on your club's grading list on 11th June in the appropriate grade.

Competition Format

The District Eliminations will be over the weekend of 2-4 July

Venues have been allocated based on a number of factors (Club entries/requests/historical hosting etc).

The draw for each grade will be available by 17th June. Team seedings will be based on 11th June grading list

Playing Rules

C-F/J Grades play PAR 15 and use a single dot ball (even if players have progressed to B grade after 11th June)

B Grade play PAR 11 and use a double dot ball

Superchamps Nationals

The winning team from each grade will be invited to compete at the NZ Superchamps Finals. In some cases, a second BOP team in some grades may be invited to make up numbers at the national event.
